In addition to our WGA Table Top Night and Scholarship Awards Night, we are eager to hear our speaker, Mike Dutton PE, SE with KPFF Engineering on the topic, “Environmental Loading: Wind and Seismic.”

Mike’s presentation will cover environmental loading considerations including wind and seismic. The upcoming code will adopt the load design document ASCE 7-16 which has changes to both seismic and wind that will impact storefront and curtain wall. Effects will be reviewed so expectations can be adjusted. The presentation will also include structural considerations for performance mock up testing from testing standards AAMA 501.4 and 501.6 and the difference between these two tests and when to use them. In particular, building drifts will be reviewed in detail as they pertain to curtainwall design.
