Incidents of falling glass from exterior balcony railings in high-rise condominiums has resulted in new standards and building code requirements that address post-breakage performance of glass. While tempered glass is an approved safety glazing, it does not provide glass retention after breakage. As a result, many railing specifications are calling for laminated glass to provide safety from falling glass. This presentation will examine the safety concerns around glass in railing systems and the new building code requirements that address the use of these systems. The results of impact testing will be presented. In addition, the need to verify the compatibility of sealants and grouts and the edge quality of glass will be discussed.
