Over the last ten years, more and more jurisdictions have required bird-friendly design for at least some new buildings. New York City will start enforcing Local Law 15 in January, requiring all new construction, from homes to sky scrapers, to use bird-friendly strategies for 90% of glass below 75 feet. The Federal Bird-safe Buildings Act recently passed the House. Why is this necessary? What is bird-friendly design? Is it the same as bird-friendly glass? Is this an opportunity or a burden?
